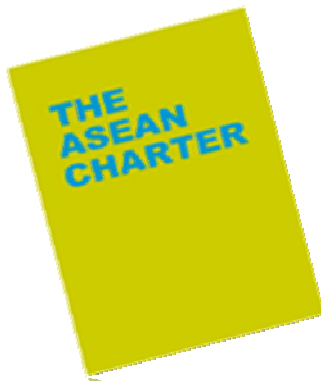
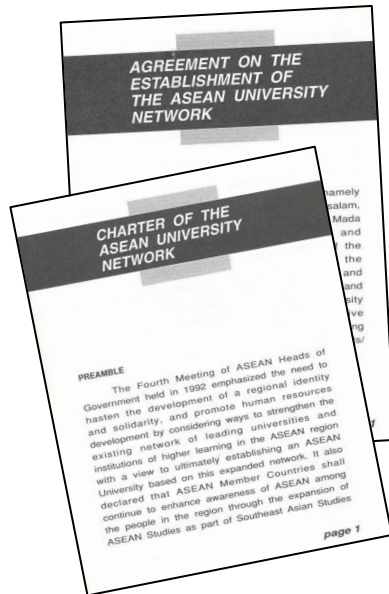
In Brief

1992 ■ **Fourth Meeting of ASEAN Heads of Government**

1995 ■ **Charter of the ASEAN University Network** was signed by the ASEAN Ministers responsible for higher education.

■ **Agreement on the Establishment of the ASEAN University Network** was signed by the Presidents, Rectors and Vice-Chancellors of participating universities.

2008 ■ **One of ASEAN Sectoral Ministerial Body**

Building regional system

- **AUN Quality Assurance (AUN-QA)**

Initiated

by the 4th AUN Board of Trustee Meeting in 1998.

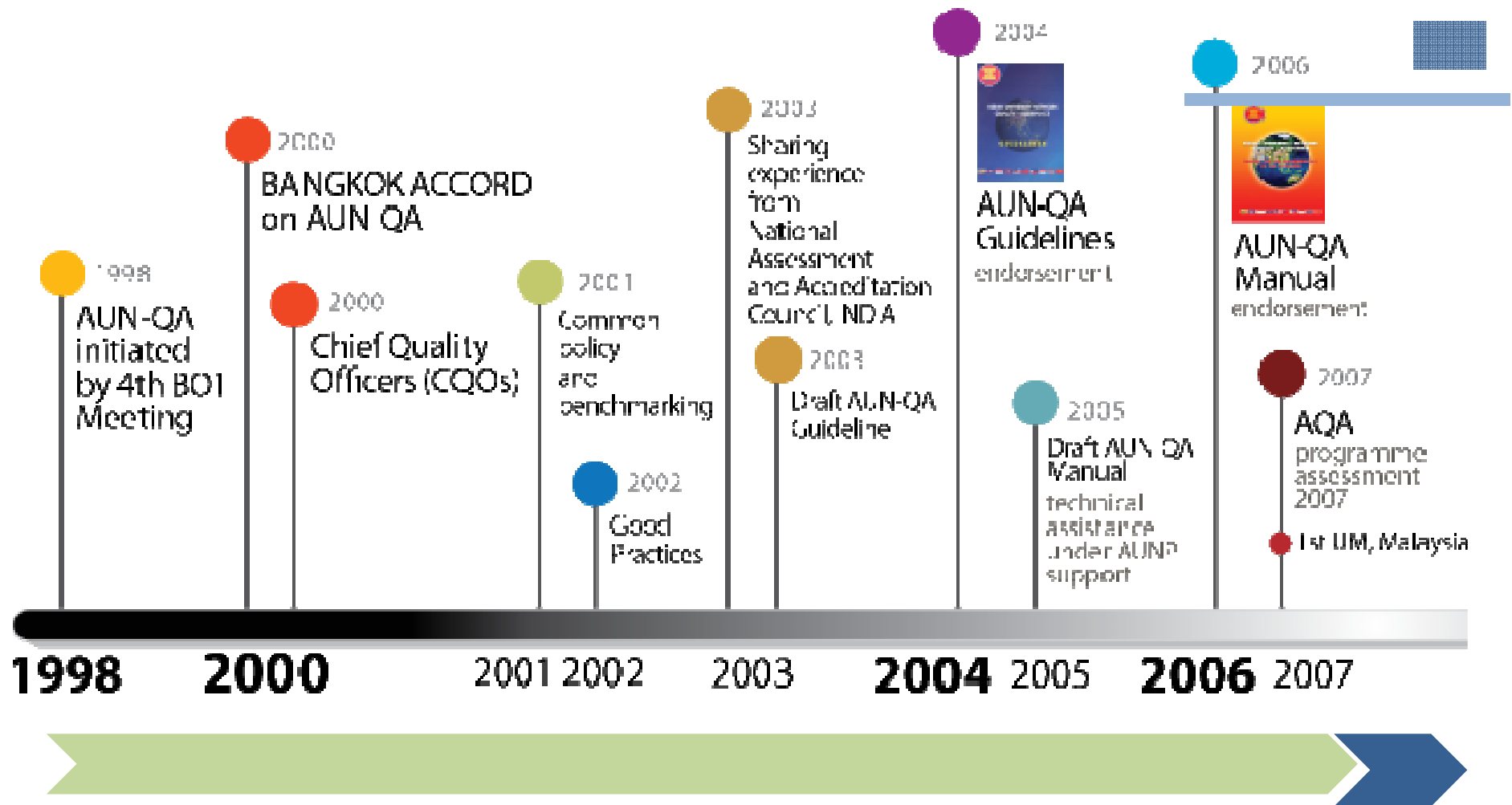
Aims

to develop QA network as regional mechanism to uplift and enhance higher education standard among the members.

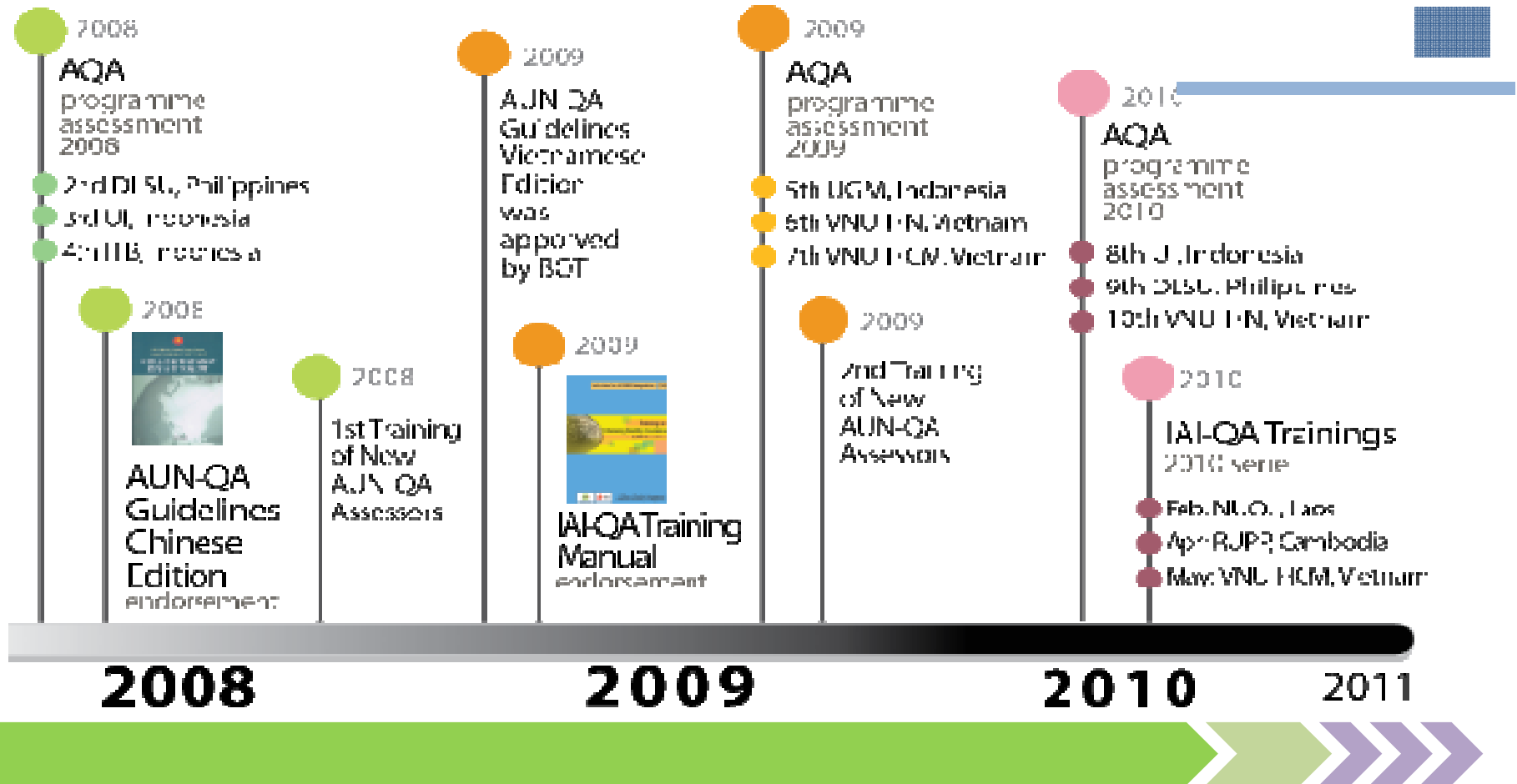
Chief Quality Officers

to be appointed by the Presidents of member universities with responsible for QA cooperation in ASEAN

Currently, 29 undergraduate programmes were assessed by AUN Assessors.

ASEAN-QA

- is a capacity development project in QA, SE Asia
- serves as
 - a platform for exchange between IQA and EQA in ASEAN and in cooperation with ASEAN & European experts
 - a mean to strengthen a regional QA structure in ASEAN



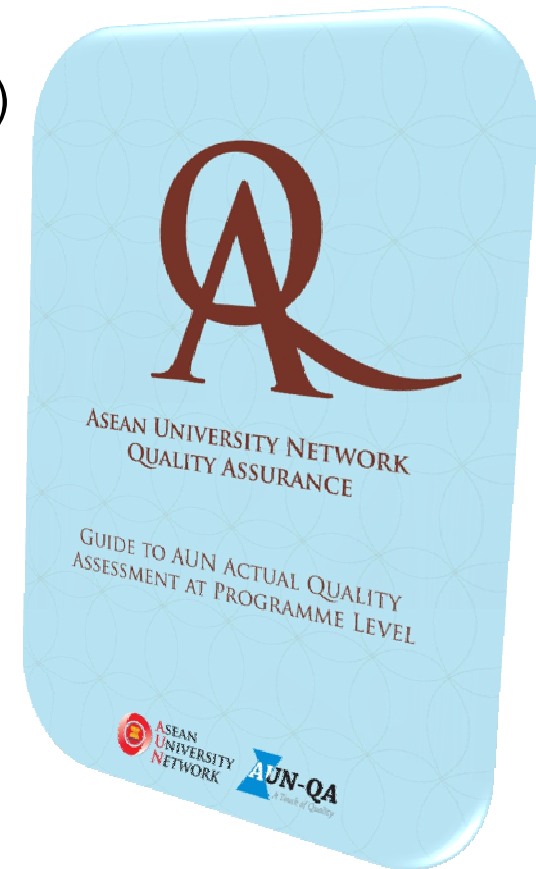
- MoU was signed by all partners on 4th July 2011.
- ASEAN-QA started in September 2011.

ASEAN-QA Training: IQA

- **Aims at**
 - assessing the programme level to support student mobility in the SE Asia
 - strengthening the AUN-QA system to make it compatible with national accreditation systems
 - benchmarking with international QA agencies in HE to improve quality aiming for international recognition

IQA Training

- **Participants:**
 - 24 University QA officers (internal QA)
 - from 10 ASEAN nations
 - AUN Members (15) + Non-AUN Members (9)
- **AUN-QA Manual** as training document
- **QA-experts:** from Singapore, Indonesia, Philippines, Germany, Spain
- **3 trainings:**
 - 1st Training, 17-21 Oct 2011, Bangkok
 - 2nd Training, March 2012, Potsdam
 - 3rd Training, Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam
