

Building regional system

AUN Quality Assurance (AUN-QA)

Initiated

by the 4th AUN Board of Trustee Meeting in 1998.

Aims

to develop QA network as regional mechanism to uplift and enhance higher education standard among the members.


Chief Quality Officers

to be appointed by the Presidents of member universities with responsible for QA cooperation in ASEAN




AUN Quality Assurance: Development

ASEAN-QA



- is a capacity development project in QA, SE Asia
- serves as
 - a platform for exchange between <u>IQA and EQA</u> in ASEAN and in cooperation with ASEAN & European experts
 - a mean to strengthen a regional
 QA structure in ASEAN



- MoU was signed by all partners on 4th July 2011.
- •ASEAN-QA started in September 2011.



ASEAN-QA Training: IQA



Aims at

- assessing the programme level to support student mobility in the SE Asia
- strengthening the AUN-QA system to make it compatible with national accreditation systems
- benchmarking with international QA agencies in HE to improve quality aiming for international recognition


