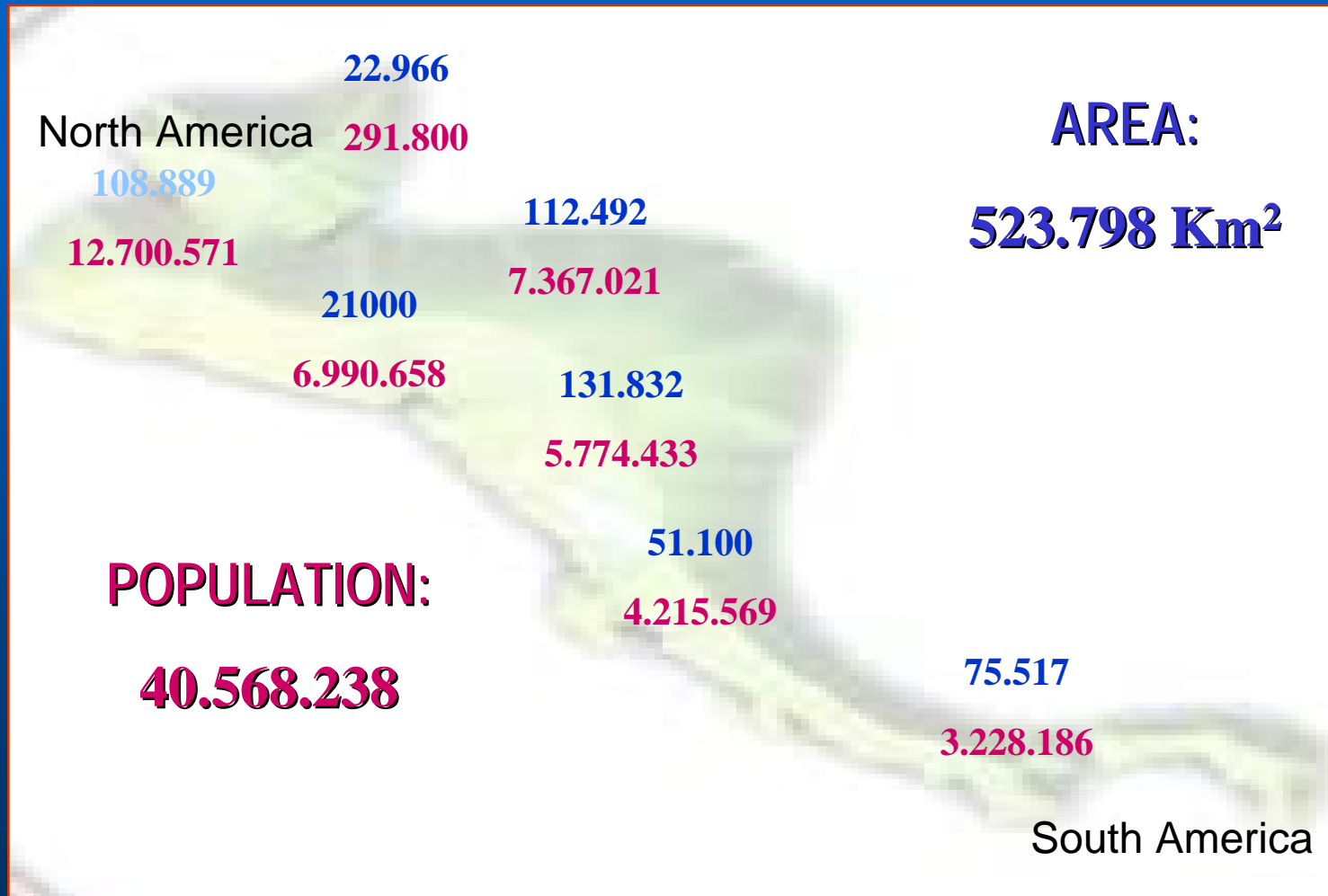

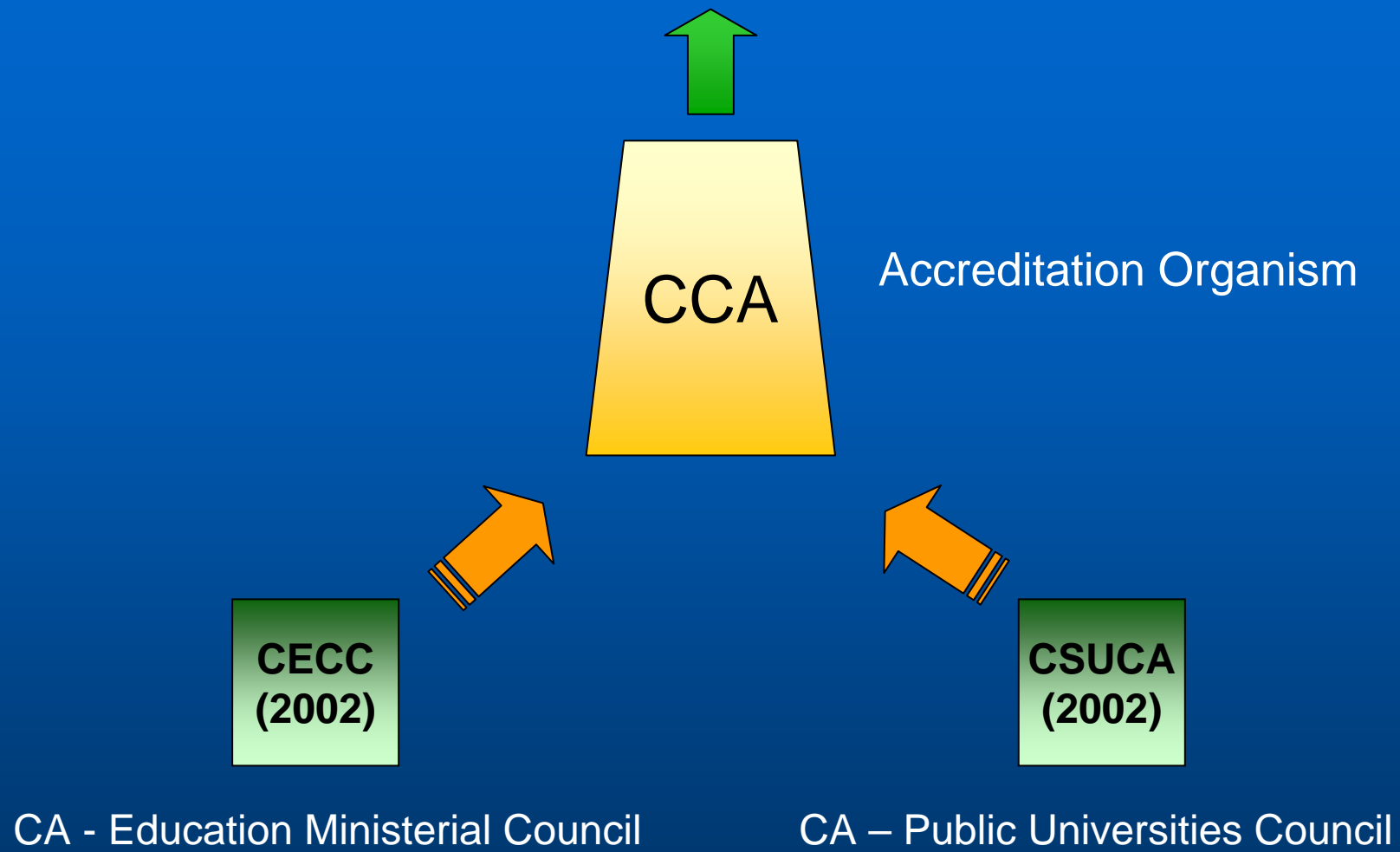

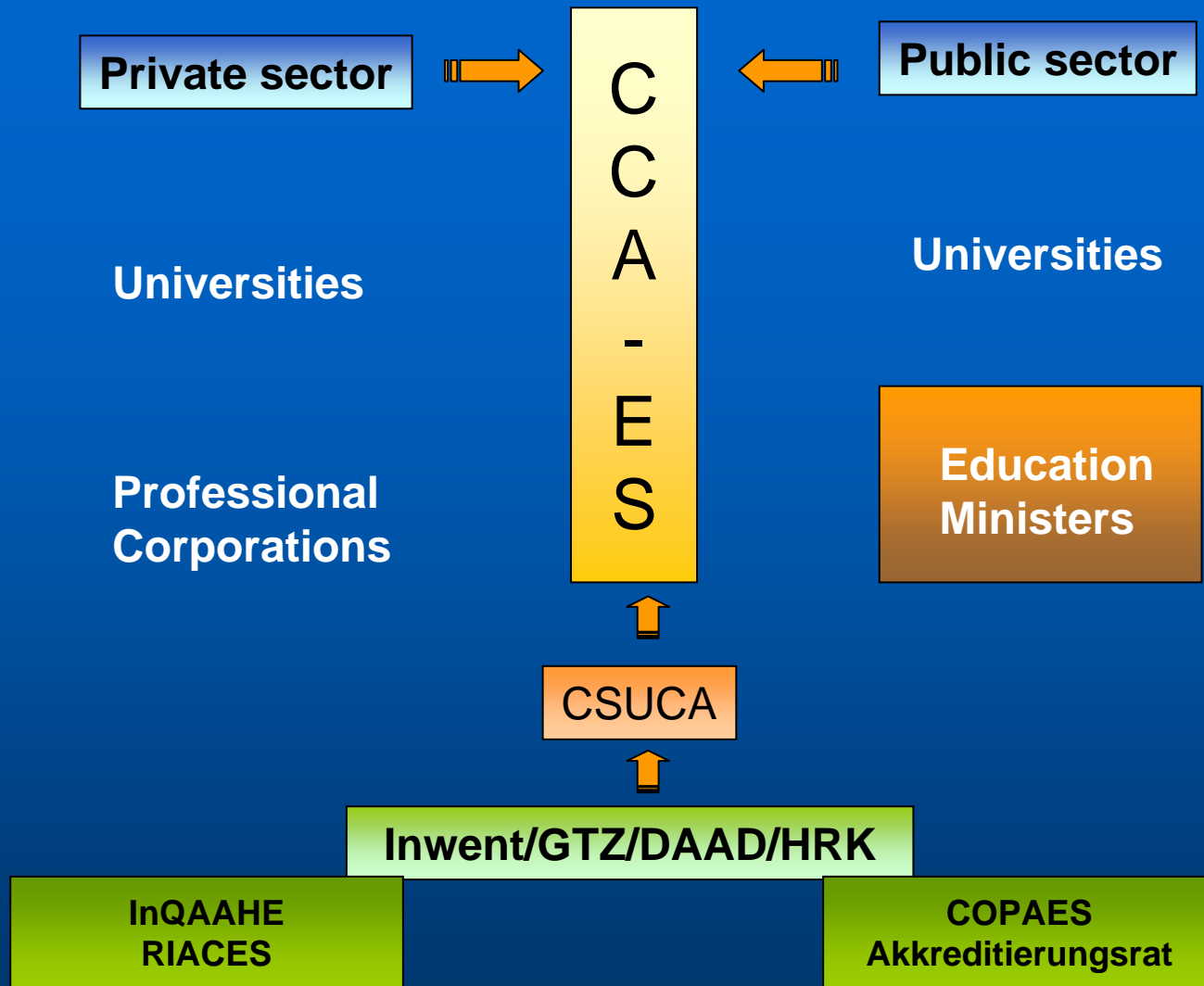
Area and Population, Central America

It belongs to SICA, the Central American Integration System with regional competencies on education and culture

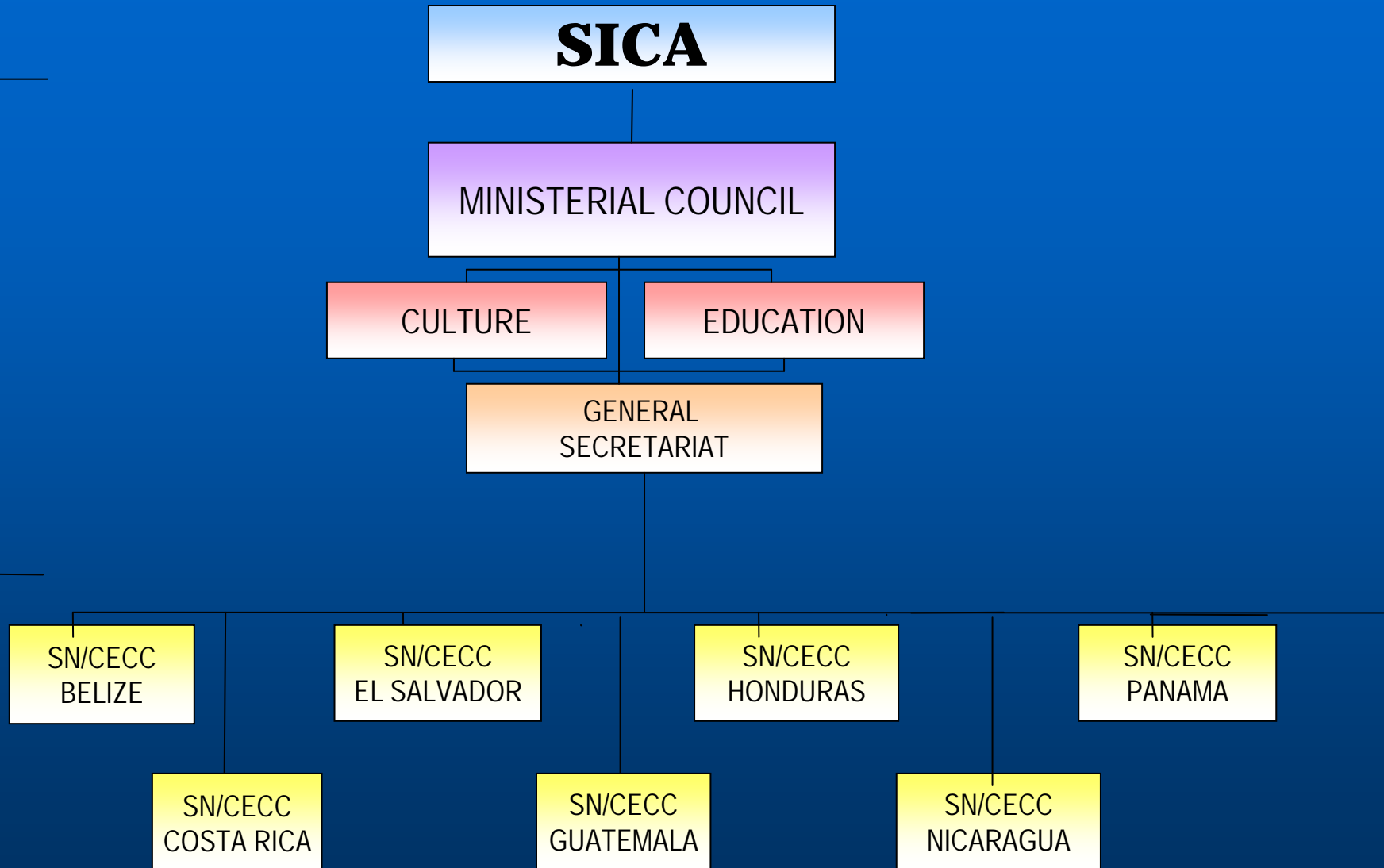
Promote cooperation for Central American Integration on education and culture

CECC Origin

- 1975- (02/08) It got started as an UNESCO's network of educational systems in Central America
- 1982- (13/11) It was transformed on the Coordinating Committee on Education for all 7 Central American countries, at a ministerial level
