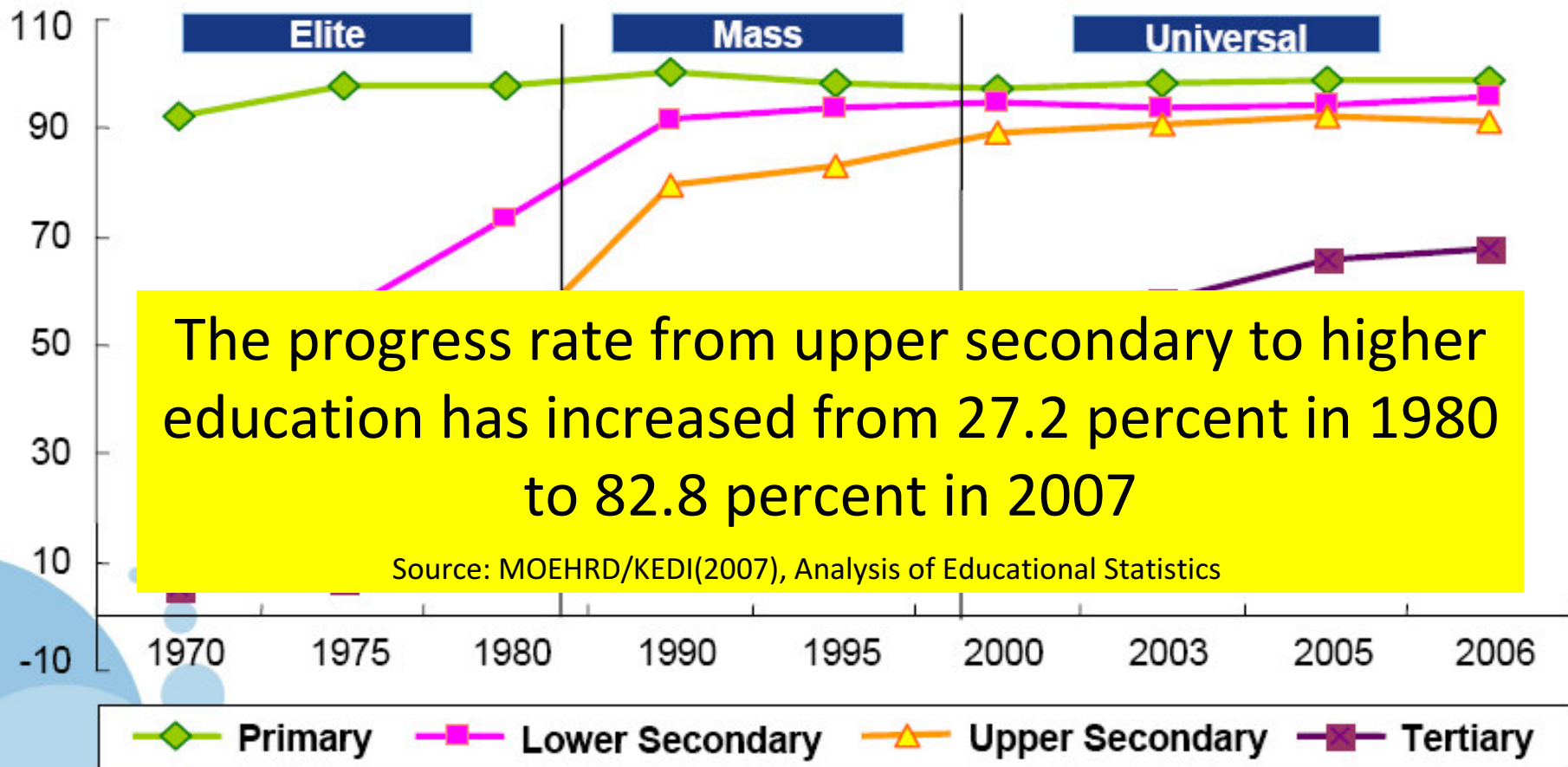

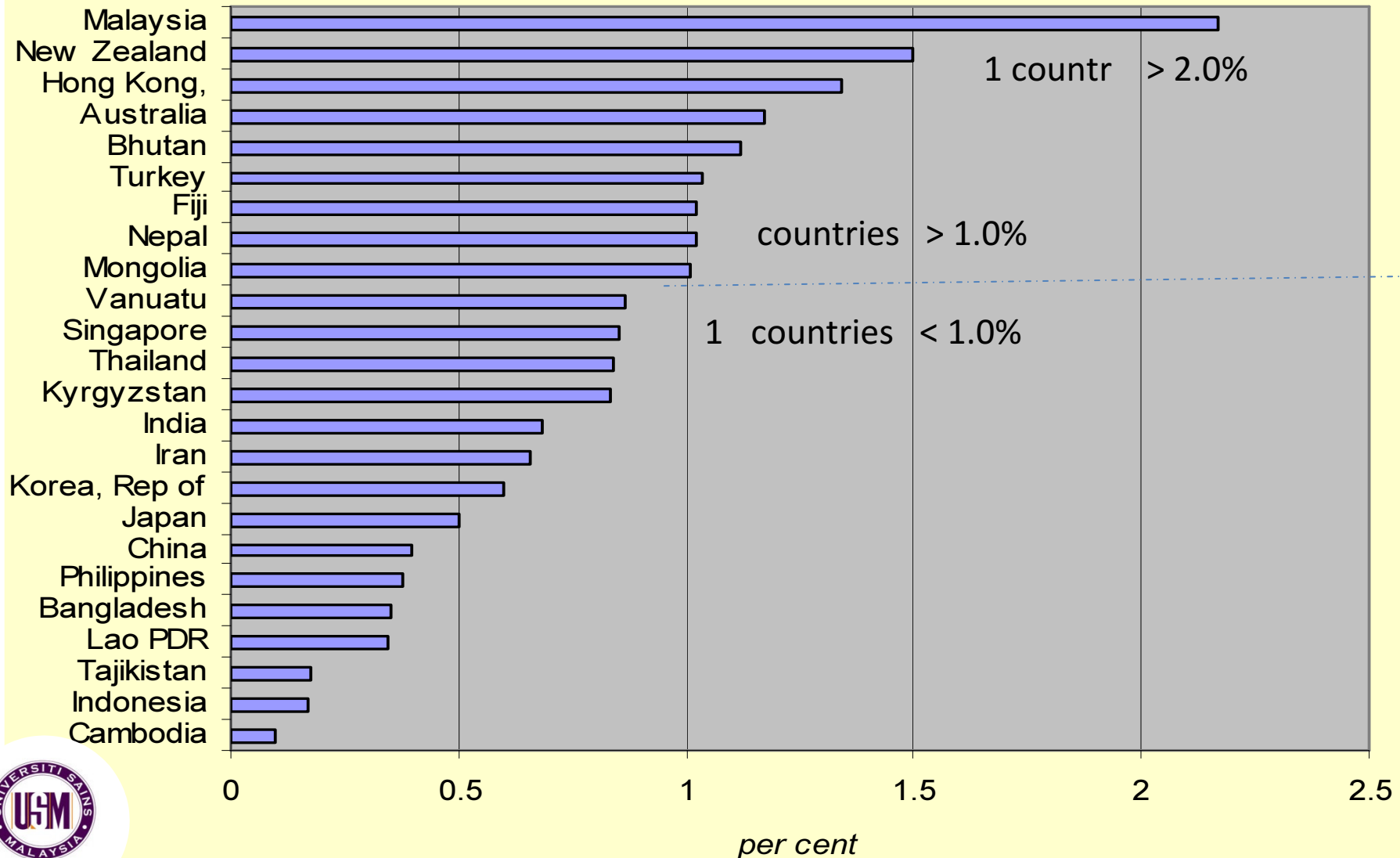

**% GDP Allocated to Tertiary Education, 2002-05**

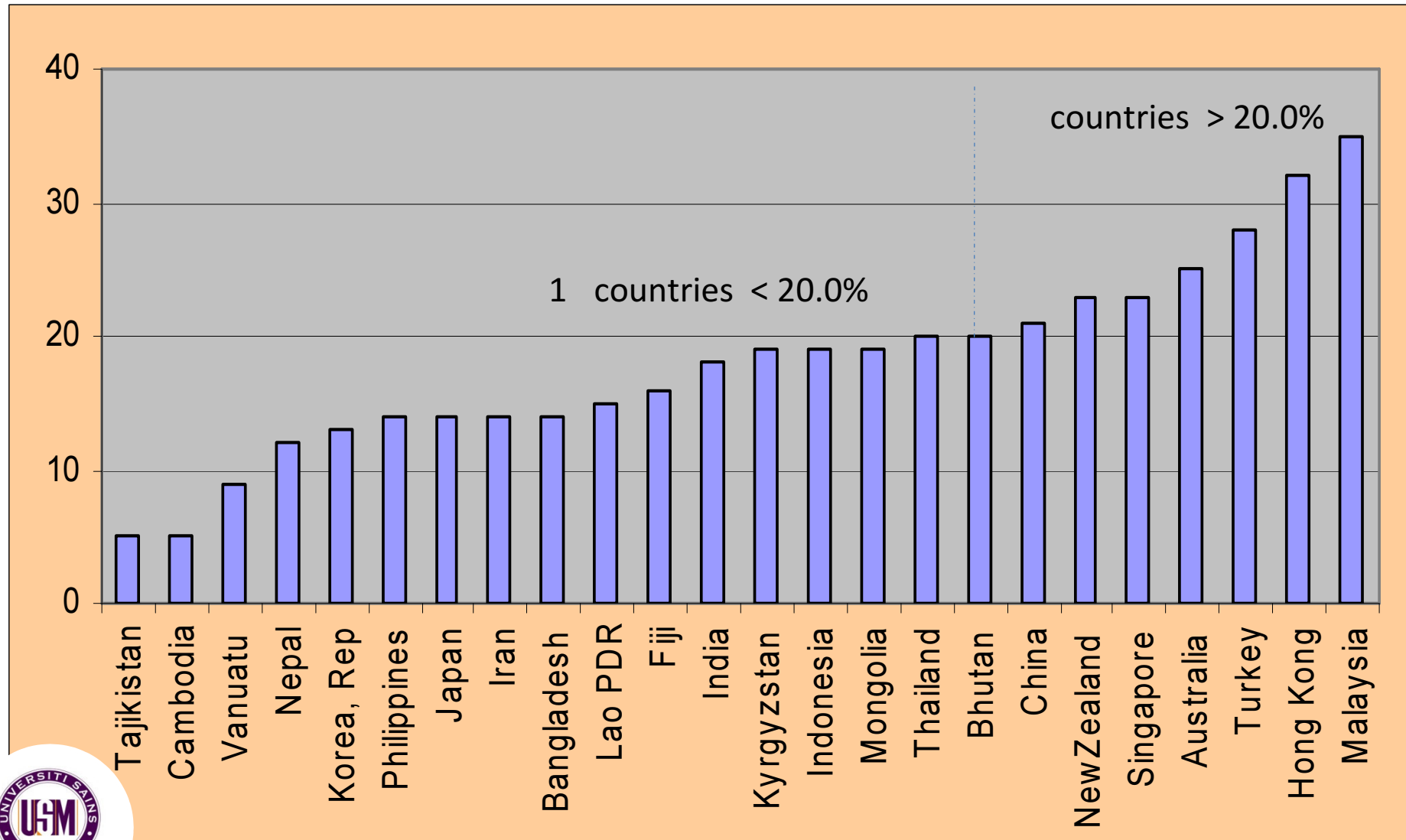
