Rankings measurement and indicators highlight areas needing continuous improvement. This resulted in the bar being raised, driving the internal quality and standard within an organization.

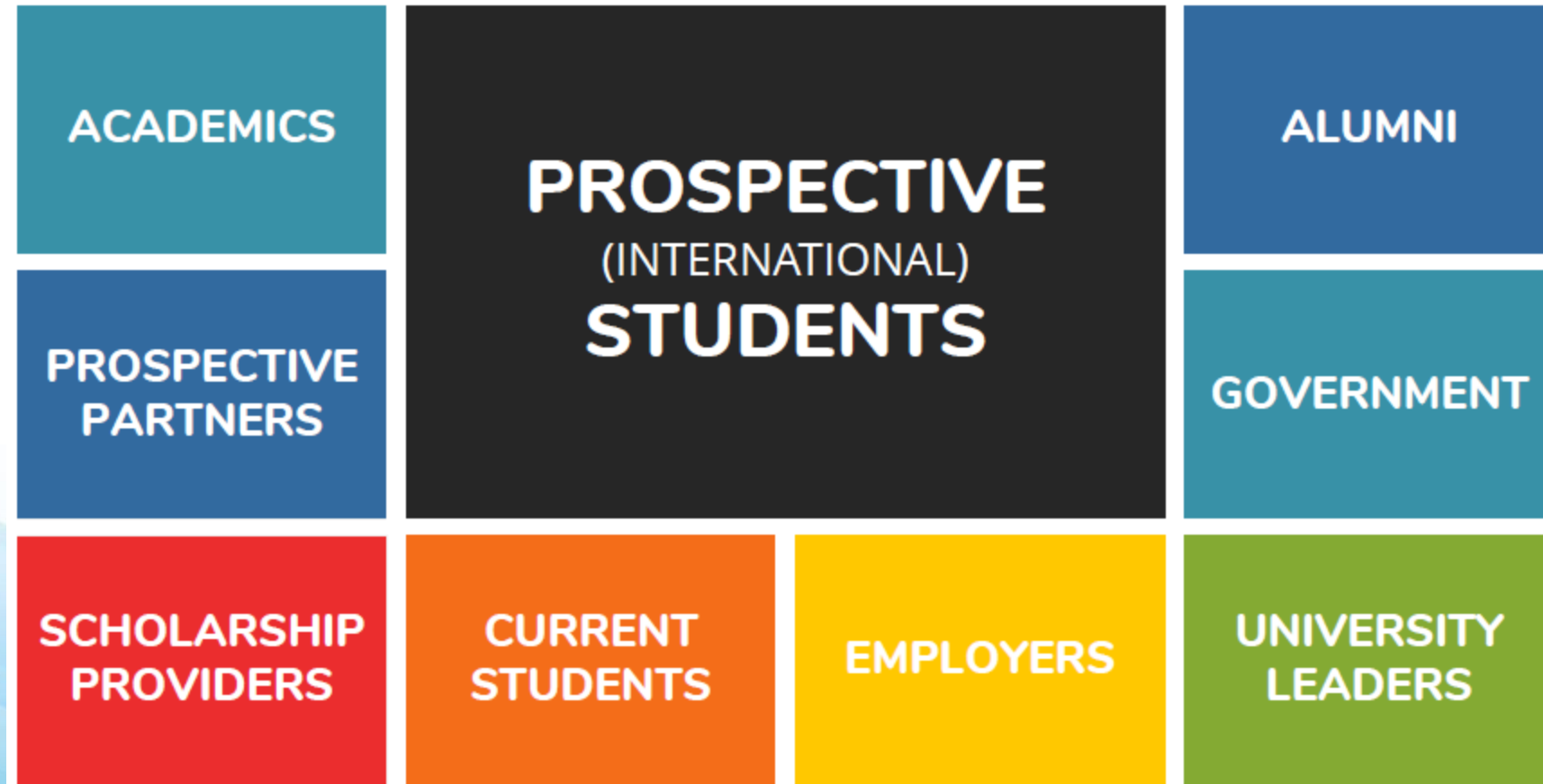


Enhance employability of graduates

Audience of Rankings



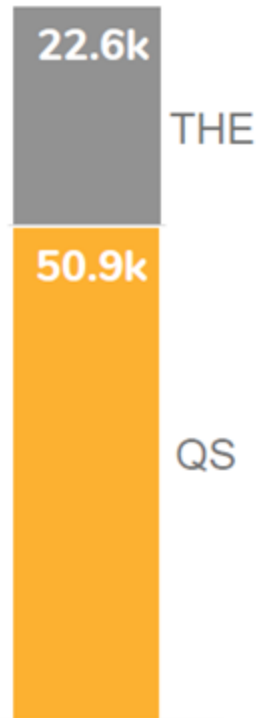

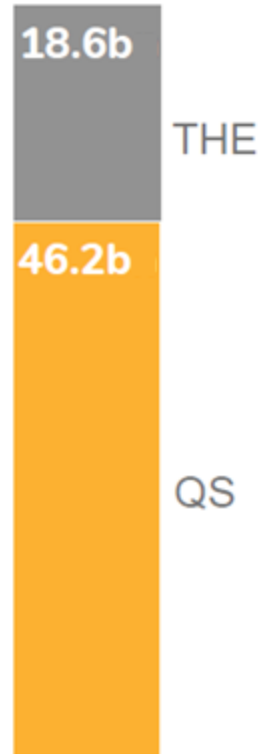

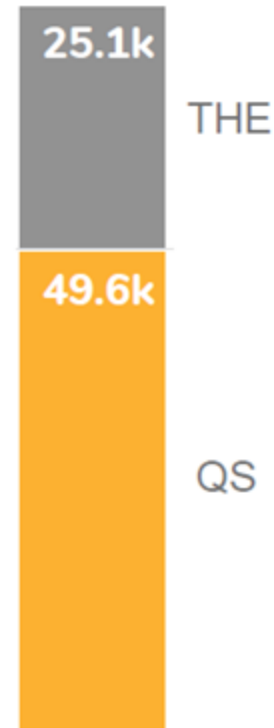
Estimated Reach

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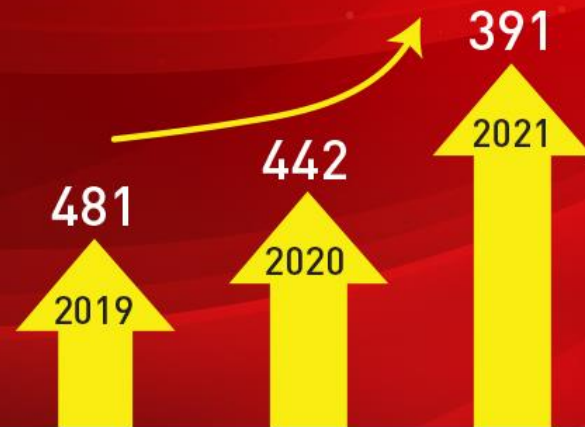

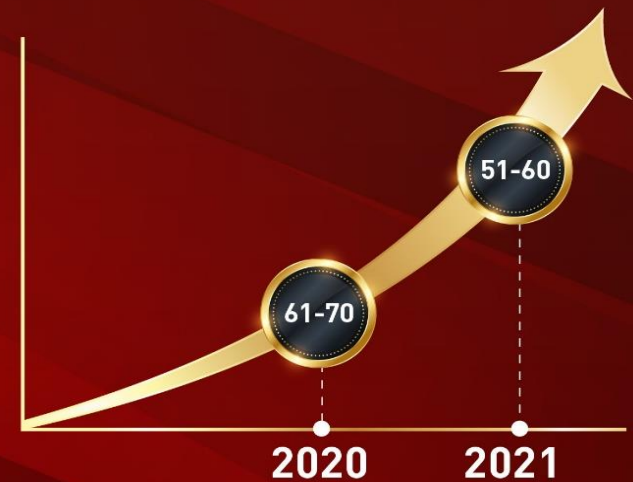

PREMIER CO-OP PARTNERS

UCSI's Premier Co-Op is an enhanced version of UCSI's flagship Co-Operative Placement Programme which has the honour of being Malaysia's most extensive university-industry network with more than 4,200 companies in partnership. Each study year, UCSI students embark on a two-month internship to gain practical industrial experience and networking opportunities. This has translated into a track record of high graduate employability for UCSI – in fact among the highest in the country.

We work with leading industry partners to provide scholarships to selected students with the potential to contribute positively to the organisation upon their graduation. This arrangement allows organisations to identify top talents and to seed an impactful relationship from the very start. A specific training programme is in place between UCSI and industry partner to provide talent and leadership training to the top students, who are jointly selected by both parties. Recipients may be required to attend the co-op (internship) training with the industry partner throughout the co-op periods of their studies. Further conditions are applicable according to the specific requirements of the industry partner.

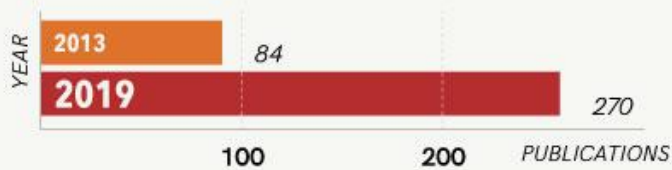
