




The Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM)

- Established: 1996
- Membership: 45, Representing half of the world's GDP, almost 60% of the world's population and 60% of global trade.
- Mission: Asia & Europe working together to meet global challenges.
- Core work: cultural, intellectual, and people-topeople exchanges between Asia and Europe.
- The ASEM Education Hubs (AEH): a network of research centers of excellence in different academic fields relevant to Asia-Europe relations.




The flow of students cross-borders

Distribution of foreign students in tertiary education, by European countries as destination (2007)



Tsinghua's efforts in building the world-class university


Since the 1990s, Tsinghua University has worked hard to build up a comprehensive, research-oriented, and open-minded university with the world class standard.

 Ceremony at RWTH Aachen of November 16th, 2007




Foreign University's Week.

- In May 2008, Tsinghua-University of Tokyo Week was held in Beijing. Over 200 professors and students from University of Tokyo visited Tsinghua.

Top visits and speeches at the campus

In 2007, Tsinghua received 26,000 overseas visitors including:

- 9 state leaders or former state leaders,
- 23 ministers, vice ministers, state governors and mayors,
- 17 ambassadors,
- 158 presidents and vice presidents from leading universities overseas;
- 35 Board Chairmen and CEOs




- Johannes Rau, President of Germany, visited Tsinghua and delivered a speech on Sep. 12, 2003.



Structure changes of international students in Tsinghua





图 3-3 1999-2007 年在校留学生结构变化情况(数据来源: 国际处年鉴)


Tsinghua faculty and students going abroad
