Abstract

This chapter looks at a new frontier in the internationalization of online education: providing access to higher education to those who have fled conflicts. It details the work of Kiron Open Higher Education (KOHE) and Jesuit Worldwide Learning: Higher Education at the Margins (JWL) to create routes to higher learning for refugees through online courses.
